Moreover, this will help keep the students together and in communication with each other. Lao Tzu, having spread his knowledge all over the world over his decades of teaching, would like to see his students come together as one family and train to perfect the knowledge that he has taught them. We feel this will be an invaluable tool to both keep students motivated and accountable for their training, as well as keep them together as one family no matter where they may be.
